NORTHFIELD VILLAGE CAUCUS BIENNIAL TOWN MEETING SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 18, 2018

Northfield, Illinois, September 17, 2018 – The Northfield Village Caucus will hold its biennial town meeting to introduce and confirm its slate of candidates for Village Trustees for the forthcoming general election to be held on April 2, 2019. The town meeting will be held on Thursday, October 18, 2018 in the Village Hall Council Chambers, 361 Happ Road in Northfield at 7:30 pm. The nominees for Village Trustees are Corinne Carr, Thomas “Todd” Fowler and Thomas Roszak. Roszak will be standing for election to a second term. All nominees are to fill a four year term. Northfield residents are invited to attend the meeting.

The Biennial Town Meeting agenda will include:

- Report of the Nominating Committee;
- Introduction and Statements by candidates slated for the positions of Village President and Village Trustees;
- Entertainment of motions from the floor in accordance with the Northfield Caucus By-Laws (posted on its website);
- Ratification of the proposed slate;
- Adoption of the Northfield Village Caucus Platform (posted on its website);
- Report of the Membership Committee and solicitation of new members.

The Caucus will assist its slate of candidates in the gathering of petition signatures starting at the Town Meeting. Under Village rules, all nomination papers of candidates are to be filed during the filing period which is Monday, December 10, 2018 through Monday, December 17, 2018 at the Village Clerk’s office, Northfield Village Hall, 361 Happ Road, during the normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. On the last day of filing Monday, December 17, 2018, the Village Hall will remain open until 5:00 pm to accept nomination papers and petitions.
