3. Winnetka-Northfield Chamber of Commerce

Terry Dason, Executive Director

Terry has a background as a former shop owner so she understands the issues facing small business owners.

The Winnetka and Northfield Chambers were combined in 2011. Winnetka in 2011 had 200 members and Northfield had 80 members. The combined Chamber now has 350 members.
